

WORK FOR THE BONUSES

There are two kinds of bonuses you can get through Tupperware - on your personal sales and on your team sales, once you're titled as Manager or above. Both are paid based on a sales month's sales volume.

Personal Sales Volume Bonus (PSVB) - When you personally sell \$1500+ in a month, you get the bonuses based on your final personal sales. This includes all sales credit from parties, online orders, etc. You can check your personal sales total at any time by going to My Sales, then clicking Unit. Your total sales for the month will be listed there (both personal and team). From \$1500- 3500, the bonus is roughly 5%. Notice that when you hit \$4000+ in a month, the percentage goes up roughly to 10%, so it's worth it to pay attention to how close you are.

Vanguard Bonus (AKA Manager Bonus) - When your team sells a minimum of \$3000 (including your personal sales), you have 3 active team members (if you don't know what active is, message your recruiter or Director when you have your team members and they can walk you through it) and minimum \$500 personal sales all in one sales month, you step up to manager. Any month that you meet those same qualifications after stepping up, you earn the Vanguard Bonus. As your team grows, it's worth it to pay attention to maximize your team bonus.
